On behalf of the Hudson County Alliance to End Homelessness, I would like to thank you for the generous donation of 1000 toiletry kits for the 2010 Project Homeless Connect. The kits were distributed to the hundreds of homeless consumers who attended the event. We believe that the event was a great success, and many homeless consumers attended that day and were able to access the goods and services that were available.
